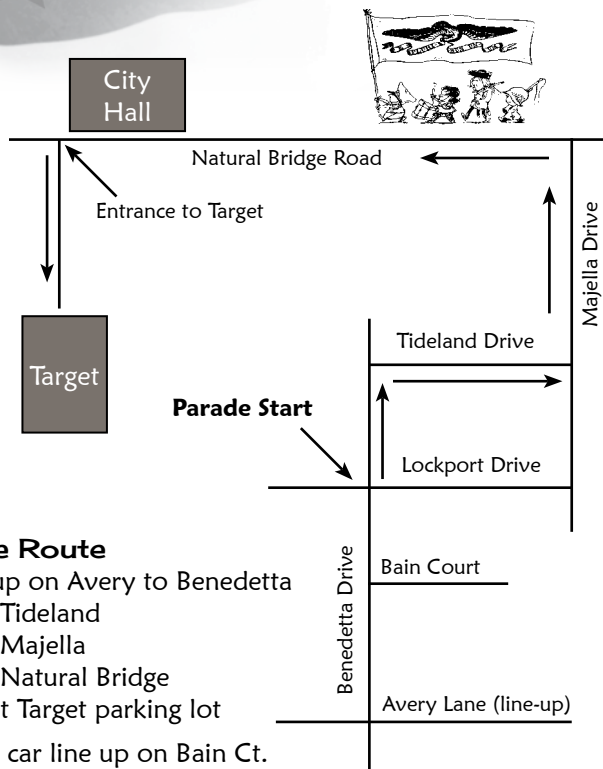




City of Bridgeton: Fourth of July Celebration
